A relaxed, high standard and elegant hotel with a warm personal service, the Victoria and Alfred is ideally located in the heart of the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. There are 94 comfortable rooms each with a view over the Alfred Basin, Table Mountain or the piazza. The OYO Restaurant and Cocktail bar is a trendy venue specialising in seafood and has dramatic views. Other facilities include a pool area in a beautifully manicured garden, pool bar and al fresco dining area. Complimentary wireless internet is available throughout the hotel.





Day 03 CAPE TOWN



#### Private full day Cape Point tour

Your journey to Cape Point takes you along the scenic Atlantic seaboard coastal road. Pass the pristine beaches of Clifton and Camps Bay with their soft white sand and azure blue water. The formidable 12 Apostles Peaks rise above the road on one side, while sheer cliffs and incredible rock formations drop into the icy Atlantic Ocean on the other side. There is no doubt the coast of the Cape Peninsula offers magnificent scenery with its great biodiversity. Arrive at the quaint fishing village of Hout Bay with its imposing sentinel. Visit Seal Island (cruise ticket payable locally) or shop for souvenirs at the craft market at the harbour. Your tour continues over Chapman's Peak which offers amazing photo opportunities and onto the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve.

This area is home to magnificent 'fynbos', many different species of antelope and birds, the Cape Mountain Zebra, and mischievous baboons. These creatures entertain guests enjoying lunch at the restaurant, which has splendid views of False Bay. Take the funicular (ticket payable locally) to the lighthouse to see the meeting of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans at the Cape Point. Visit Boulders Beach to see the Jackass penguins (entrance payable locally), travel through the naval base of Simonstown and then venture inland to your last stop of the day at Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. With the sun setting over the tall peaks of Table Mountain the last rays sparkle on the trees and flowers, and offer a fitting end to a day filled with all the Cape has to offer.

## Day 04 CAPE TOWN

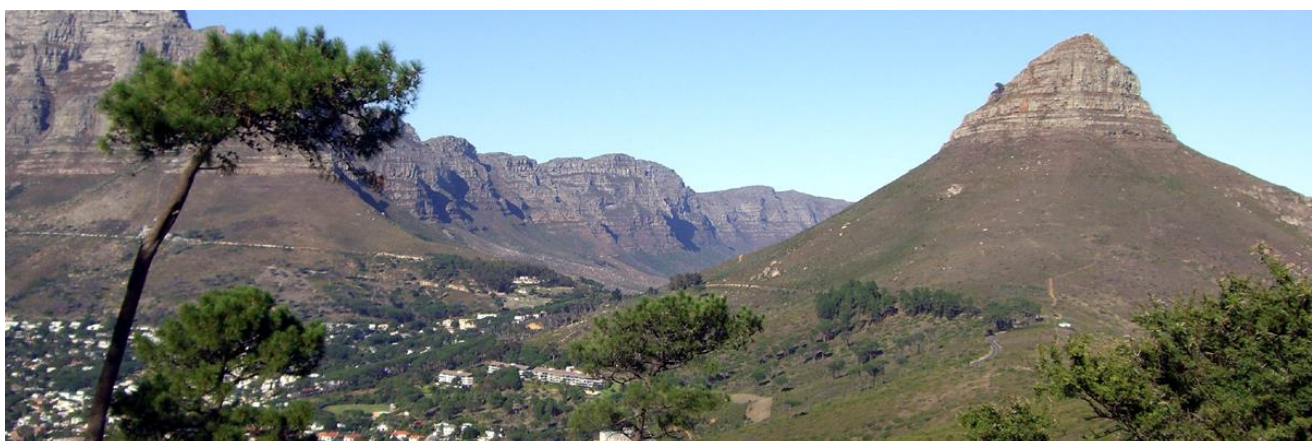
At leisure to enjoy and explore Cape Town, perhaps take a trip up Table Mountain.



Cape Town is South Africa's oldest city and is stunningly situated between Table Mountain and the clear waters of the Atlantic. The 'Mother City' is truly one of the world's most beautiful cities and is packed with immense charm and historical interest.

Take a cable car up Table Mountain, a boat to Robben Island or simply enjoy a leisurely stroll through Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. Indulge yourself at the vineyards of elegant Constantia, see the brightly painted houses of Bo-Kaap, experience colourful townships or simply relax on a nearby beach. Cape Town is a diverse and iconic city that offers something for everyone and warrants an extended stay.

As well as its many sites, the shopping and dining options are equally appealing. The modern Victoria and Alfred Waterfront development has numerous specialist stores, craft markets and eateries with stunning views of the mountain and its characteristic 'tablecloth' of cloud.

Hermanus has the status of being the best land-based whale watching destination in the world. Southern right whales visit Walker Bay from June through to December and can be viewed from aboard a boat, an airplane or from the shore. Hermanus is home to the world's only Whale Crier who blows his kelp horn when whales are spotted along the central sea route. Originally a fishing village, Hermanus is charming all year round and has numerous arts and crafts shops and restaurants.

Private transfer to the airport for your onward flight to the Kruger National Park with South African Airways.

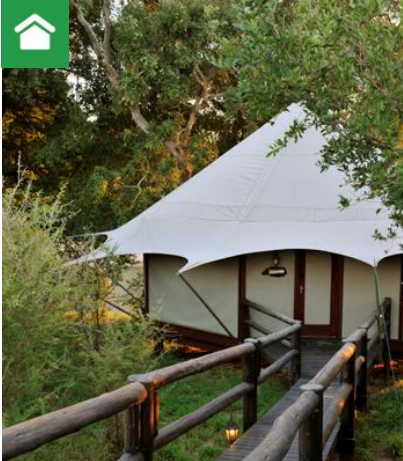

Following the fine tradition of luxury in true 'Out of Africa' style, the journey into a bygone era inspires one to experience safari. Hamiltons Tented Camp allows indulgence in pure luxury, combined with the sounds and smells of the African bush. Six magnificent canvas tents complete with teak floorboards, dreamy mosquito nets, slipper baths, outdoor showers and a superb view of the seasonal river are linked to the main lodge area by raised timber walkways amongst ancient Jackalberry trees. Uncompromising elegance and breathtaking beauty identifies Hamiltons Tented Camp. Magnificent canvas tents complete with teak floorboards, dreamy mosquito nets, slipper baths, outdoor showers and a superb view of the seasonal river are linked to the main lodge area by raised timber walkways amongst ancient Jackalberry trees. **GREATER KRUGER**



Established in 1898, the world famous Kruger National Park is impressive in both its size and diversity of wildlife; the park is home to 147 mammals, 114 reptiles and 507 birds. Covering nearly 2 million hectares of protected South African lowveld, the park is also home to a number of interesting bushman rock paintings and archaeological sites. Within the park, it is possible to self-drive on an excellent network of sealed roads. Accommodation is available in either rest camps within in the park or at a number of good quality lodges in private concessions. Kruger gives you the opportunity to enjoy a self-guided safari or you can hire knowledgeable park rangers locally. However you spend time in Kruger you will be rewarded with vast open spaces, stunning African sunsets and star filled skies.

Children travelling with only one parent or other person or where one parent or both parents are deceased, must be in possession of an affidavit from the remaining parent/s or guardian, permitting the child to travel or copy of the deceased person's death certificate when applicable.
