**Day 03 BUENOS AIRES****Shared half day city tour**

Cosmopolitan and vibrant, Buenos Aires is a modern capital city with a distinctly European feel. There are many good museums, plenty of green open spaces and the architecture is striking. Away from the centre, several of the traditional neighbourhoods still remain. San Telmo has a quaint faded appeal with cobbled streets which really come alive on Sundays when the weekly antiques market is held. The area of La Boca, established by Italian immigrants, is well worth a visit to see the colourful buildings. Synonymous with Argentina, Eva Peron's final resting place can be seen amongst the grand and ornate surroundings of the Recoleta Cemetery.

**Day 04 BUENOS AIRES**

Day at leisure to explore Buenos Aires.

**Shared evening excursion to Dinner & Tango show at Esquina Carlos Gardel**

Named after the greatest tango singer of all, the 'Esquina Carlos Gardel' is located on the site of the 'Chanta Cuastro' restaurant where Gardel used to meet friends in the 1920s and '30s to eat, drink and sing late into the night, and is acknowledged as the city's premier Dinner & Tango Show. The superb food and service, together with the stylish art nouveau interior, recreate the sophisticated and luxurious atmosphere of that era. The show is a spectacular mix of live tango music, singing and dancing and features some of the most talented performers in Buenos Aires.



**Day 05 BUENOS AIRES - EL CALAFATE**

Private transfer to Buenos Aires Domestic Airport for your onward with LAN.

Located a few blocks away from the centre of town, the Posada Los Alamos is El Calafate's best hotel. The hotel has 144 rooms with beautiful views of the gardens and the Andes. All rooms feature LCD TVs with cable channels, CD players and minibars and there is complimentary wireless high-speed internet access. There is also a small golf course, spa, indoor pool and steam room at the hotel and for those looking for a more active stay there is a fitness centre on site and fantastic walking nearby. Posada Los Álamos offers guests multiple dining options at the restaurant, café and bar/lounge and prides itself on its delicious traditional dishes.



**Day 06 EL CALAFATE**



**Shared full day excursion to the Perito Moreno Glacier**

A two hour drive from El Calafate takes you to the Perito Moreno Glacier, considered by many to be the most beautiful glacier in the world. Wonder at the spectacle that is the 180 foot high, 3 mile wide and 20 mile long mass of ice. Certainly one of the most spectacular natural wonders in South America, the brilliant white glacier is slowly retreating and you will not have to wait for long before a large chunk of ice breaks away and crashes into the lake below. You will walk along the paths located in front of the glacier's western wall, allowing you to view this natural wonder from a variety of different viewpoints.



**Day 07 EL CALAFATE - TORRES DEL PAINE**



Private transfer across the Chilean border to Torres del Paine. Covering an area of over 180,000 hectares, Torres del Paine has been declared a world heritage site by UNESCO. The centrepiece of the park are the mighty Torres, huge granite pillars that rise upwards from the surrounding mountains. There is an abundant supply of wildlife and several bird species that can be found nowhere else. Sites included in the tour are Lake Sarmiento, Laguna Amarga, Paine Waterfall, Salto Grande, Cuernos del Paine, Lake Pehoé and Nosedenskjold.

You will be dropped off at Laguna Amarga where you will meet a shared transfer to your hotel.

**Río Serrano**



**1 x Standard Monte Balmaceda Room on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 3-nights**

This beautiful hotel is located on the eastern bank of the Serrano River and boasts a panoramic view of the Paine Mountain Range and the chance to enjoy unforgettable sightseeing tours and activities such as kayaking, horseback rides, trekking and fly-fishing close to the hotel. The hotel has 20 large, double standard and 30 superior rooms, all with private bathroom, central heating and telephone, all very cosy and pleasantly decorated. It also has a pleasant dining room, where you will be able to taste the region's most typical dishes, all with excellent service. It also has a large lounge with comfortable armchairs, television and heating, where you will be able to enjoy a relaxing end to the day or simply admire the scenery.

**Hotel Casa Don Tomás**



**1 x Standard Room on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 3-nights**

Located close to the centre of San Pedro de Atacama, this cosy and welcoming hotel offers comfortable rooms with rustic furniture, electric heating and en-suite bathrooms. Built in the traditional style of the region, the hotel's facilities include a restaurant, swimming pool and terrace with views towards the volcanoes in the distance.



**Shared afternoon tour to the 'Moon Valley'**

One of the most spectacular places in the Atacama Desert, Vallé de la Lune (or Moon Valley) is a fantastic moon landscape that is a part of the Cordillera de la Sal (Salt Mountain Range) belonging to the Los Flamencos National Reserve. It is a small depression 1,650 feet (500m) in diameter full of strange sculptural shapes that are the result of geological shifts in the earth's crust. The lack of humidity and life has turned it into one of the most inhospitable places on the planet. Highlights of the tour include reaching the salt figures or 'Tres Marias' around sunset and the chance for an optional short hike to one of the giant sand dunes in the valley.

**Day 12 SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA****Shared full day tour to San Pedro, Toconao & Atacama Salt Lake including lunch**

After breakfast, will visit San Pedro de Atacama; the centre of a Palaeolithic civilization that built impressive rock fortresses on the mountains encircling the green valley. The colonial church was constructed in 1577 and is the largest and most beautiful church in the region. The extraordinary archaeological museum of Padre Gustavo Le Paige has many archaeological pre-Hispanic artefacts.

After this visit you will drive around 4km to reach the pre-Columbian village of Tulo (around 3000 years old). The archaeological remains here are the oldest evidence of human settlement in the valley.

Then continue your morning tour to Pukara de Quitor. This fortress was conquered in 1540 by the Spanish conquistadores defeating the Incan troops who, in turn, had captured it from the pre-Incan cultures and extended the fortification. In the afternoon you will start your tour to Toconao, a village where locals dedicate themselves to the manufacture of white volcanic stone sculptures.

You continue to the huge Atacama Salt Lake, an inland sea formed millions of years ago. Be overwhelmed by one of the most spectacular and dramatic landscapes in Chile!





**Day 13 SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA**



**Shared full day excursion to El Tatio Geysers & Machuca including picnic breakfast**

You will be collected from your hotel early (around 04:00) and head north to the famous El Tatio Geysers. El Tatio are situated at 4320m above sea level on the Altiplano, making them the highest geysers in the world. Here, powerful spurts of steam shoot out from various blowholes and there are about 40 geysers, thermal wells and fumaroles. Enjoy a picnic breakfast next to the geysers. If possible (depending on the activity of the geyser) you can take a bath in the hot thermal pools.

Later drive on to visit Machuca, a former ancestral people, with houses built in the traditional way. You will arrive back at your hotel around 13:00 and enjoy an afternoon at leisure.



**Please Note:**

Due to high altitude and early departure it is recommended to have a light dinner the night before and no alcohol. Also it could reach up to -15°C/5°F bring warm clothing, sun cream, sun glasses

Shared transfer to Calama airport to meet onward flight with LAN.

**Day 15 SANTIAGO**



**Shared half day city tour**

Flanked by the Andes Mountains to the east and the Pacific Ocean to the west, Santiago is one of South America's best located capitals. The architecture is generally modern although some colonial buildings do remain. The climate is favourable and many vineyards can be found in the surrounding countryside. The tour starts with the city centre sights such as La Moneda, (the Government Palace), the pedestrian streets of Huérfanos and Ahumada and the famous Plaza de Armas, the main square of the city, which is surrounded by the Metropolitan Cathedral and other historical buildings. It then continues to Santa Lucia hill, where the Spanish founded Santiago in 1541, which gives great views of the Parque Forestal and the Mapocho River, before continuing on to the cultural district of Bellavista and finishing at the restaurants, elegant shops and modern high-rise buildings of Providencia.



**Day 16 SANTIAGO - DEPART**

Private transfer to Santiago airport to meet your return flights to the UK, flying with Iberia.
