

#### 1 x Deluxe Garden View Room on a Bed & Breakfast for 1-night

Set in the hills of Alto Las Palomas in the west part of San José, this lovely upscale hotel is just 10km from downtown San José. Offering unique character and first-class service, it has earned itself a spot inside the prestigious group of the best Small Luxury Hotels of the World. The property has a collection of 23 rooms & suites which are beautifully styled and feature private balcony or terrace with views over the lush tropical gardens. At the La Luz restaurant and bar you will be able to enjoy Mediterranean and Costa Rican specialties. Other facilities include an outdoor pool with whirlpool, a small gym with sauna & a library area.





#### Day 02 SAN JOSÉ – TORTUGUERO



#### Shared transfer by road and boat to your Tortuguero Lodge

You will take a shared transfer through the spectacular Braulio Carrillo National Park, along the way admire the biodiversity and keep an eye out for wildlife. Stop for breakfast en-route where you will be treated to a typical Costa Rican breakfast. On arrival at Caño Blanco / La Pavona Pier you will take a boat through the canals until you reach your lodge.

#### **Boat Transfer - Luggage Restrictions:**

There is an official luggage limit of 12kg per person on the boat transfers. But as luggage is not weighed and the limit is not actually enforced, luggage up to 23kg is acceptable.

#### Evergreen Lodge







#### 1 x Standard Room with Full Board & Shared Activities for 2-nights

Enjoying a fantastic location, only five minutes from the entrance to Tortuguero National Park this lovely rustic lodge is removed from the resort style atmosphere some similar properties portray. Its 55 spacious rooms are all nicely decorated, if a little basic, and provide everything you will need for a very comfortable stay. The lodge boasts a nice restaurant, a bar in front of the lagoon and a delightful turtle shaped pool. Other facilities include free WiFi in the reception area, tropical garden, hammocks to enjoy the jungle views and a Spa.

Upon arrival at the lodge you can enjoy a refreshing cocktail before having time to settle in. Lunch will then be served ahead of an afternoon excursion.

#### Shared excursion to Tortuguero Town and the Green Turtle Information Centre

Tortuguero is a unique, beautiful village with a rich culture. Because there are no cars, you will walk worry free. Sandy trails and raised cement walkways wander through the town. You'll see a lot of typical Caribbean architecture and artwork, as well as get a glimpse into the lives of the local people. The Green Turtle Information Centre is located at the far north end of the village. Here you can learn about the nesting cycle of the turtles and about the other wildlife that calls this National Park their home.



#### Day 03 TORTUGUERO



#### Shared morning walking tour

This morning you will explore Tortuguero on foot, a region rich in flora and fauna. Walking through the hotel trails observe big trees like the almond mountain tree (macaws love the fruits), cativos, chilamates (giant trees) and plants like heliconias, rubiasas, peperasia and many more. Bird watching is fantastic here too with an abundance of toucans, woodpeckers and golden orioles. Endearing sloths, white faced capuchins and the raucous howling monkeys are also found here.

#### Shared afternoon canal excursion

This afternoon you will get to explore the park's freshwater creeks and lagoons, which will be navigated in small open boats, giving you the chance to observe spectacled caimans and river turtles. The surrounding dense rainforest is also rich with wildlife, from monkeys to many bird species.

Turtle nesting season is between July and September. Tours to see this natural spectacle can be arranged locally. Tortuguero National Park is home to some of the world's finest nesting sites for endangered green turtles. Nocturnal guided tour allows you the chance to see the females, who weigh around 300 lbs, haul themselves up the beach (the same one where they were born), dig a nest and lay their eggs before returning to the sea. Later in the season watch the hatchings make the long trek to the sea.





#### Day 04 TORTUGUERO – LA PAVONA – GUAPILES - ARENAL

Shared boat transfer to Caño Blanco / La Pavona pier; disembark to meet a road transfer to Guapiles where lunch will be served at El Ceibo Restaurant.

Private transfer to Arenal and your hotel (3 hrs).

#### Arenal Manoa







#### 1 x Standard Room on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 3-nights

Located 7km west of La Fortuna this hotel is surrounded by La Palma River, making the area an ideal refuge for a great diversity of birds, mammals and lizards, besides a large variety of plants. Amidst tropical gardens, the 80 rooms have been appointed such that each one offers a panoramic view of the volcano. The hot spring pool and ponds are fed by natural mineral water, which have therapeutic properties. In addition, the hotel has its own spa, restaurant, sushi bar and pizzeria.





Day 05 ARENAL



#### Shared half day Sky Tram & Sky Walk excursion

Take an aerial tram through the rain forest to appreciate the Arenal Volcano and the Arenal Lake from a different perspective. The tram takes about 20 minutes to reach the observation platform at the highest point of the Arenal Reserve with opportunities to make intermediate stops. It is a guided tour and includes a 25-minute walk in the rain forest. To descend from the platform, it can be done either on the aerial tram or on the Sky Trek canopy tour. To enjoy the canopy, you will be securely attached to a zip line and slide down cables stretched across platforms over the top of the forest canopy. From this vantage point you will get breath taking and exhilarating views of the canopy as it rushes beneath your feet. Whilst the tour will certainly get your adrenaline pumping, you will be strapped into a secure safety harness so you will be completely safe throughout the tour. It is possible to do it attached to a guide for added assistance and you can leave the tour at any of the platforms if you find it a little too exhilarating!





Day 06 ARENAL



#### Shared full day Rio Balsa rafting tour (Class II-III Rapids)

Rafting the Rio Balsa is perfect for families or first-time rafters. Located just 45 minutes from Fortuna, this route is gentle yet has enough challenges to ensure the excursion is exciting and an adventure. Before you begin guides will give you a through safety talk and equipment to ensure you are safe on the river. Enjoy the stunning scenery as you pass and keep an eye-out during your excursion for the wildlife around you such as monkeys, sloths and tropical birds including toucans. A local lunch is included.

Facilities at the hotel include two infinity swimming pools with a swim up bar, an adult pool with cascading waterfall, tennis court, fitness centre, mini-golf, computer centre, and seven restaurant-dining options.

Day 08 MANUEL ANTONIO





#### Shared half day tour to Manuel Antonio National Park

This National Park is one of the most popular in the country thanks to its wide variety of flora and fauna. During this tour, you will be accompanied by a knowledgeable nature guide and take a 2 mile trail that is flat and picturesque and loops through the park. Throughout the hike, the guide will stop and explain what is being observed. Halfway through the hike, a 20-minute stop will be made at one of the stunning beaches for everyone to rest on the beach or play among the waves if they choose so. Throughout the hike they will be able to observe sloths, birds and reptiles, as well as admire orchids, butterflies and tropical trees. The guides are equipped with Pentax and Swarovski telescopes that you can use to observe wildlife and take pictures with a different perspective.



Day 09 MANUEL ANTONIO





#### Shared half day ocean kayaking and snorkelling including lunch

A challenging open ocean paddle along one of the most beautiful coastlines in Costa Rica. Visit nearby islands where seabirds such as boobies and frigates are nesting. The adventure begins in Nahomi Cove, in the town of Quepos, and winds along the Manuel Antonio coastline to reach Biezanz Bay, a nice and isolated beach. During this stop, you can snorkel to observe parrotfish, starfish, angelfish and even sea turtles. On returning to the pier, you'll head back to base camp to enjoy a little conversation over a delicious homemade meal.

Shared road transfer to the dock (5 mins).

#### Drake Bay Wilderness Resort

Located on the Osa Peninsula, Drake Bay Wilderness Resort is situated on a bluff overlooking Drake Bay, considered to be one of the most beautiful bays in Costa Rica. The resort is ideally placed, close to the Corovado National Park, making it an ideal base from which to explore the rich biodiversity found in the park. The Resort style hotel offers over 20 tropical cabins, each one comes complete with porches from which you can enjoy the stunning views over the bay, mountains and rainforest that is teeming with life. The hotel features an ocean view pool filled with warm ocean water, a pool side restaurant serving both national and international dishes and its own open air bar. Located at the end of the property is a natural tidal pool, offering you somewhere quiet to soak and relax while taking in the stunning nature that surrounds you.

Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, relaxing on the beach, kayaking on the river, or exploring one of the self-guided hiking trails.







#### Days 11 - 12 DRAKE BAY

Shared guided activities.

During your stay, you have two guided activities included. Choose from Mangrove & Bird Island tour, horse-riding, visit to Corcovado National Park, or boat trip and snorkeling at Caño Island.



Drake Bay is considered one of the most beautiful bays in Costa Rica, it is surrounded by a rainforest teeming with diverse flora and fauna. One of the main attractions to this area is its incredible biodiversity and located a short distance from the bay you will find the world famous Corcovado National Park, home to 2.5% of the world's total animal species. There are also over twenty species of whales and dolphins to be found in the area with even more who migrate to Drake Bay to breed. For those wishing to catch a glimpse of the animals, you can book a whale and dolphin watching trip locally (additional costs will be incurred). If you would prefer to stay on dry ground whilst admiring the areas natural beauty there is also a popular night time tour of the amazing local bug life. Drake Bay features a plethora of more adventurous activities including snorkeling, hiking, horse riding and swimming.
